

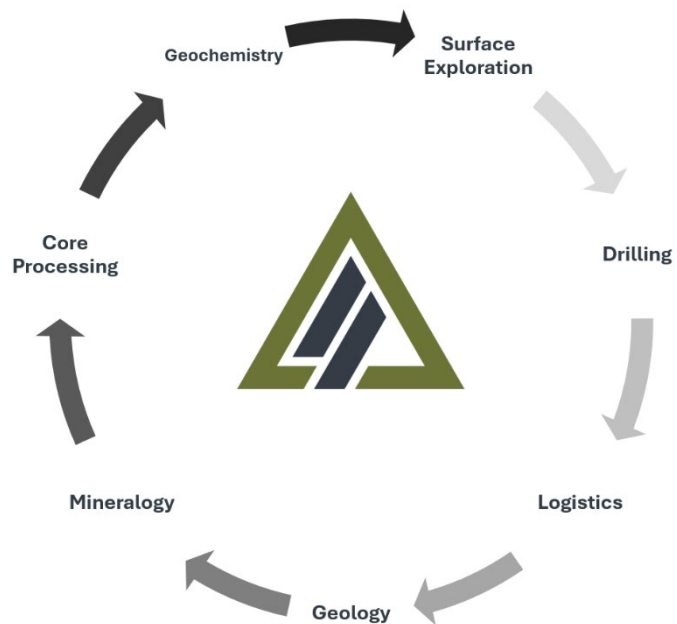
Scout Discoveries – Full Stack Exploration and Drilling Services

The team includes both operational personnel and technical experts, allowing Scout to execute exploration projects from concept through to drill testing in-house.

Scout's Integrated Advantage

By integrating both the operational infrastructure and employing experienced personnel across all key roles from claim staking through drilling, Scout is uniquely positioned to:

- **Surface Exploration:** claim staking, sampling, prospecting/mapping.
- **Drilling Logistics Management:** Road/pad building, road maintenance, water hauling.
- **Surface Core Drilling:** Five surface core drills with capacity to 3.1 km depth.
- **Geologic Support:** Drilling management, onsite quick logging, and core prep.
- **Advanced Core Imaging:** TerraCore hyperspectral core imaging.
- **Digital Logging and Sampling:** Detailed digital core logging, sampling, cutting.
- **Discounted Prep & Assaying Services:** full suite prep and assaying at Scout's partner analytical lab.

Scout Drilling LLC – wholly owned surface core drilling company with five surface core rigs with 24/7 operational capability and 3.1 km NQ depth capacity; up to 50,000m annual drilling capacity:

- *Track-mounted DE712 (PQ-HQ-NQ to 1400m), skid-mounted HC5000 MAX (PQ-HQ-NQ to 3100m), two track-mounted LF-70s (HQ-NQ to 700m), skid-mounted HC2000 (HQ-NQ to 1000m) core drills; support equipment including water trucks and telehandlers*
- **President and General Manager** – oversee and lead all operations of the drilling company, set and drive safety culture
- **Drilling Foremen (6) and Safety Managers (2)** – Supervise drill crews, manage drill schedules, and ensure compliance with safety and performance standards.
